Celebrating 20 years of God's Goodness!

In our August issue we recounted the first 10 years of the AABS history, how God began the work of making Biblical education available in local churches and communities. This month we continue with highlights

of the succeeding years up to the present.

By 2018, National Directors had been appointed in Liberia, Sierra Leone, Nigeria, Ghana, Togo, and Benin, and a West Africa Region Director was appointed. A significant contact occurred when the Director of an existing Bible academy in Botswana came across our website and contacted us. This was our introduction to Dr. Jeremiah Mothibi, who had been a pastor and Bible scholar for thirty years and recently decided to quit pastoral ministry and focus only on training and equipping church leaders. He was enthusiastic about what AABS offered.

In 2020 I appointed him as our Botswana National Director, and within two years he brought 17 more schools into the AABS family. Dr. Mothibi presently serves as our Southern Africa Region Director. This is one example of many significant contacts that God has arranged for us through the years.

In the past four years we have experienced remarkable, almost explosive, growth. In 2020 we appointed Interim National Directors to serve the East African countries of Kenya and Uganda. Also in that year we resourced leaders in the Rhino Refugee Camp - Uganda. In 2022 an AABS representative was ap-

pointed to serve the nine member schools in Burkina Faso and we also added a new name - All-nations Association of Bible Schools - to reflect the growing number of schools contacting us from outside Africa. To date we have served schools in India, Haiti, Mexico, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Bhutan and USA, in addition to 21 African countries. In 2023 National Directors were appointed in the ten countries of the Southern Africa Region, and Tim Ingold joined me in the US as full-time Administrative Director.

I praise God for what He has done in these past twenty years. To Him be all the glory! And I also thank you, our faithful partners, for making it possible for this ministry to continue. I look forward with joyful anticipation to what God will do in the future!
